**Partners program**

**Time:** 09:00h – 17:30h

**Place:** In the morning, a coach will pick up the partners at the Hotel Palazzo delle Stelline and will drive them to the **Church of San Satiro and Bramante's optical illusion**. A guide will explain them the insights of that church.



Afterwards, they will head towards the **Duomo (Milan's Cathedral)**, where, from outside, the guide will explain them the history of such an important cathedral.



The tour will continue towards the **Gallery Vittorio Emanuele II** and the **museum of the Scala**. Once the tour is over, the guide will bring them to have an appetiser nearby (included in the price). Once the appetizer is over, they will be free either to



come back to the hotel by themselves (by taxi or by metro, which is nearby), either to visit the **Fashion Quadrilateral**, which is at walking distance from the area they will be. Between 16:30h and 17:00h the coach will be waiting at a meeting point (*La Scala*) to bring them back to the Hotel Palazzo delle Stelline.



Milan is undoubtedly Italy's fashion capital and one of its internationally-known symbolic locations. And it is in the so-called central "**Quadrilatero**" area that the major national and global luxury brands have established their businesses over the years. One of the access points, *via Montenapoleone*, is the most important and luxurious street in Milan and, with the parallel streets - *Via della Spiga* and *via Sant'Andrea*, *via Gesù*, *via Santo Spirito* - and *via Borgospesso* running perpendicularly it forms the heart of the district, historically

known as the *Quattro Borghi*. Visitors strolling around the Quadrilatero can delve in a very special atmosphere of elegant showrooms and alluring window displays. Nestled in amongst the boutiques, however, there are also prestigious buildings that play host to important cultural entities: for example, the *Bagatti Valsecchi* house museum and the historical collections of *Palazzo Morando* dedicated to costumes, fashion and image. Leaving *via Montenapoleone* in the direction of *Corso Matteotti*, we arrive in *Piazza San Babila*: until the early thirties the open space in front of the church of *San Babila* - built in the eleventh century upon the ruins of an earlier place of worship and remodeled several times over the years.

### Gala dinner

The Rowing Club of Milan is a prestigious and exclusive club near one of the points of the nightlife in Milan. It is the only centenarian sports club of Milan and the oldest in Italy. The company was founded on 15<sup>th</sup> October 1890 exclusively for rowing, but later took part in swimming, water polo, basketball, diving, tennis and athletics.

Now, it offers both facilities for sports and for wellness. There is also a restaurant with a bay window and a very elegant garden recently renovated. It is a *must* to visit in Milan and enjoy its food and sportive environment. Participants will be pick up at the hotel and brought back by coach.



**Saturday 10<sup>th</sup> June: Saturday excursion**

**Time:** 09:30h – 16:30h

**Place:** In the morning, a coach will pick up the participants at the Hotel Palazzo delle Stelline and will drive them to the **Leonardo's Vineyard**. After visiting the vineyard, participants will head towards the **Duomo (Milan's Cathedral)**. They will visit the Duomo inside and will go upstairs guided by a tourist guide. Afterwards, they will have lunch in a typical restaurant. After having lunch, participants will visit the **Castello Sforzesco (Sforza Castle)**. Once the visit is over, the coach will bring back the participants to the Hotel Palazzo delle Stelline.



A forgotten story binds **Leonardo da Vinci** to the city of Milan, the story of a **vineyard** that Ludovico Sforza, Duke of Milan, gave to Leonardo in 1498. A vineyard that Leonardo, in the years ahead, defended and maintained at all costs; the vineyard around which legends involving Leonardo, his

works and followers sprang up; the vineyard that is reborn today, within the original rows and with the original vine.

The **Duomo** is the cathedral church of Milan. It is dedicated to St Mary of the Nativity. The construction of the gothic cathedral began in 1386 and took nearly six centuries to complete. It ended in 1965. It is the largest church in Italy and the fifth largest in the world (157 m length) and its chorus windows are the biggest known. Milan's layout, with streets either radiating from the Duomo or circling it, reveals that the Duomo occupies what was the most central site in Roman Mediolanum, that of the public basilica facing the forum.



**Castello Sforzesco (Sforza Castle)** was built in the 15<sup>th</sup> century by Francesco Sforza, Duke of Milan, on the remains of a 14<sup>th</sup>-century fortification. Later renovated and enlarged, in the 16<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> centuries it was one of the largest citadels in Europe. Extensively rebuilt by Luca Beltrami in 1891–1905, it now houses several of the city's museums and art collections.

**Note:** The visit of the “**Last Supper**” of Leonardo da Vinci will be subject to the availability of tickets and time slots. More information will be provided during the stay of the participants in Milan.
