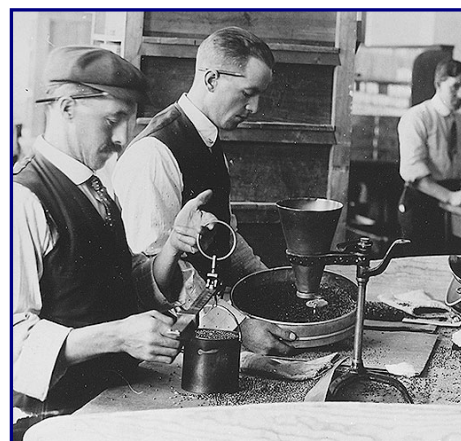

After Dinner Speaker: Brian Little

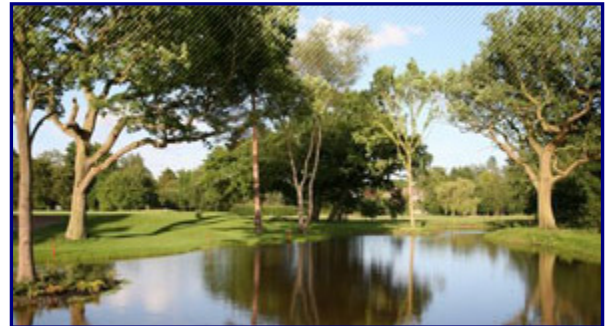
